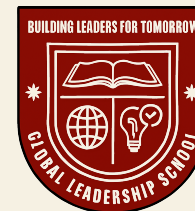

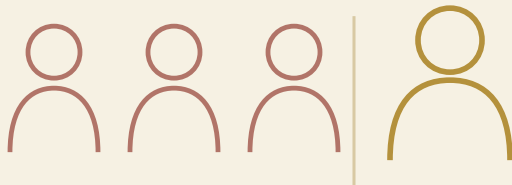

The GLS Five

A clear, repeatable process behind every student's individualized plan.



DISCOVER

Get to know the student — history, goals, learning style — case by case, not a form.



DESIGN

Build the individualized plan — courses, format, and counseling cadence.



DELIVER

Daily instruction in whichever format the student chose, backed by daily 1:1 office hours.



DEVELOP

Ongoing character & leadership growth through civics and monthly counseling.



DEMONSTRATE

Track real outcomes — grades, scores, research, service work, readiness for what's next.

Character & Leadership

At GLS, character and leadership aren’t a separate elective — they’re built into how the school runs.

SEMESTER GOAL CONVERSATIONS

Each semester, every student meets with their counselor to talk through where they stand — personally, academically, socially — and civic concerns and convictions.

COMMUNITY SERVICE & CIVIC PROJECTS

Required service hours and multiple civic projects each year — real practice contributing beyond the classroom.

PSYCHOLOGY-TRAINED COUNSELING

Every counselor has a background in psychology — personalized to how that student thinks.

AP Career Kickstart

A head start on where you’re headed. Career-focused coursework built with employers and colleges, so students graduate with both college credit and career-ready skills. GLS offers both courses.

AP BUSINESS WITH PERSONAL FINANCE

For students building toward business or entrepreneurship — business fundamentals and real financial literacy.

AP CYBERSECURITY

For students building toward computer science & engineering — how digital systems are protected.

A qualifying score can earn college credit and an employer-recognized credential.

NEW THIS YEAR



Pre-AP

Pre-AP builds AP-level habits years before a student's first AP exam — consistent expectations, real feedback, and skill-building across core subjects, so students enter grade 9 ready rather than catching up.

Students enter high school ready rather than catching up.

AP with WE Service

Learning that leaves the classroom. AP with WE Service pairs AP coursework with a hands-on service project connected to what students are studying — turning classroom material into real community impact.

A student in AP Statistics might design and run a community survey; a student in AP Environmental Science might lead a campaign around clean water access; a student in AP Computer Science might build a tool that addresses a need they've identified. The subject sets the lens; the project is the student's own.

Students who complete the service component earn a distinction on their official AP score report — a college-visible marker of leadership, not just coursework.

AP Capstone Diploma

Two years. One serious body of work. AP Capstone is built on independent research and evidence-based argument. In AP Seminar, students investigate real-world issues from multiple perspectives; in AP Research, they design and carry out an original research study.

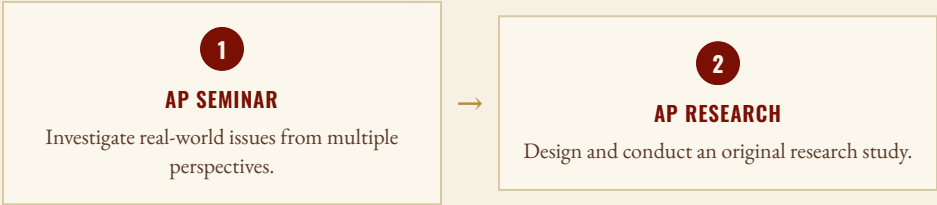
ILLUSTRATIVE RESEARCH QUESTION

A student might investigate why open-discussion social media platforms tend to push opposing viewpoints further apart — pulling from media studies, psychology, and data analysis to build an evidence-based answer.

Qualifying scores earn the AP Capstone Diploma — recognized by selective colleges as evidence of independent scholarship.
